Gain the mastery to plan, direct and coordinate medical and health services, and learn how to create and implement policy and procedures, hire and supervise staff, control finances, and collaborate with other healthcare managers. Graduates will emerge with the tools and knowledge necessary to manage teams and departments, and strategically develop balanced solutions that benefit healthcare organizations and patient care and access.
