## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The FIU Master of Health Services Administration program prepares students for executive leadership positions in healthcare organizations, with a focus on managing the human and fiscal resources to deliver effective health services. Gain the mastery to plan, direct and coordinate medical and health services, and learn how to create and implement policy and procedures, hire and supervise staff, control finances, and collaborate with other healthcare managers. Graduates will emerge with the tools and knowledge necessary to manage teams and departments, and strategically develop balanced solutions that benefit healthcare organizations and patient care and access.

Program courses prepare students for varying degrees of responsibilities as health services administrators. This includes:

- Planning, directing, and coordinating medical and health services
- Create and implementing policy and procedures
- Hiring and supervise staff
- Controlling finances
- Collaborating with other healthcare managers and stakeholders

## APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- A minimum 3.0 GPA in the last 60 credits of upper-level undergraduate coursework.
- Personal statement.
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities previously attended (undergraduate and graduate). *Transcripts must be sent to FIU directly by the institution(s) in electronic format or mailed in a sealed institution envelope.*
